

# LIVING LABORATORY



The Living Laboratory is a field trip program designed to engage students K-5 with outdoor learning and play in Santa Fe's 11-acre Railyard Park. The program aims to pique students' curiosity about the natural world, and introduce them to real-world conservation solutions being practiced in the Park.

- Four-five Railyard Park field trips from mid-March through May of 2026
- 20-40 K-5 students per field trip
- School bus stipends available
- Curriculum aligned to New Mexico science and social studies standards
- Facilitated by trained educators
- Program materials available in English and Spanish
- Subjects include: Plant and Pollinator Investigation; Physics on the Playground; Habitat Comparison; Water, Community & Acequias; and Compost Creatures
